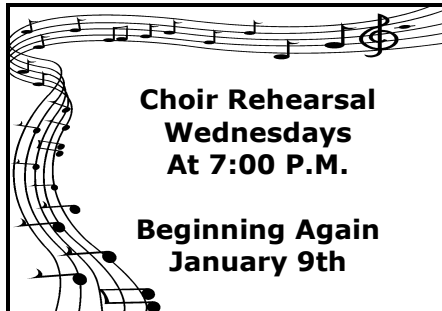

Thoughts From Doug

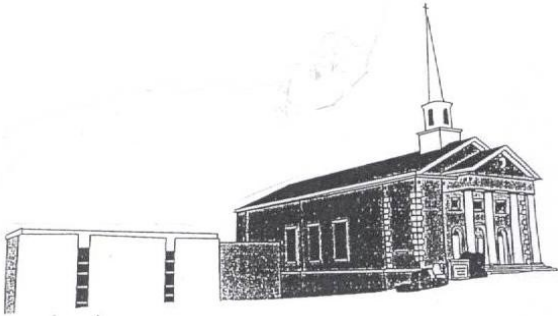
I am so looking forward to 2019, and all that is in store for us as a family of faith as we seek to step further into the adventure that is the leadership of the Holy Spirit. I am dependent on each of you to do the necessary work in your own life of discipleship: to be faithful in the prayers, the Scripture meditation, the worship gatherings, the fellowship, the serving of our community as well as each other. As we are faithful in these, and other, spiritual practices (a nod to last Sunday's sermon), we can be confident that we can together respond to God's Spirit, rather than depending on our own power, ideas, and creativity. I have prepared the next "Resource for Daily Prayer and Scripture Meditation," and it will be included as an insert in the January 6 worship bulletin. I hope you will join me in utilizing it as one spiritual practice for the New Year.

As I mentioned in last week's *Herald*, I want to say a bit more about the Wednesday night adult study that will begin January 9. We will be going through a two-month series entitled "Welcome to Dinner, Church." I have given this particular matter much thought over the years—and especially since I began as pastor with you. The "matter" to which I am referring is: how can a traditional church, consisting largely of folks who have been raised in a traditional church, engage folks who are not in church? How can we work together to share our love for God and others, with those who are either not convinced of God's love in Christ, or who feel the traditional church offers little of interest to them? It is the hope of having a serious conversation about these questions that I have planned this next Wednesday night study. I believe it will give us a *hopeful imagination* as to planning a simple, yet meaningful, way to connect with some of the people described above. I hope you can be involved in these sessions, and thus give your input and prayers to this endeavor. Let's all pay attention to what God may be saying to us concerning our calling to share the love of God, the grace of Christ, and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit with all people.
