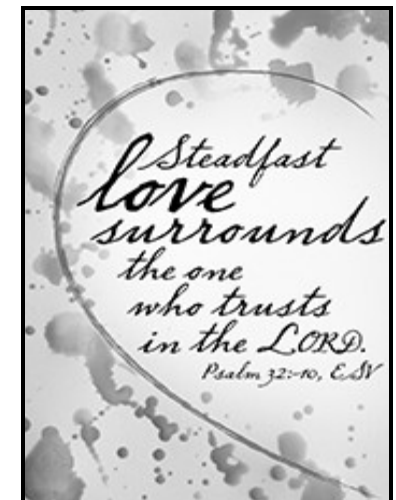

Thoughts From Doug

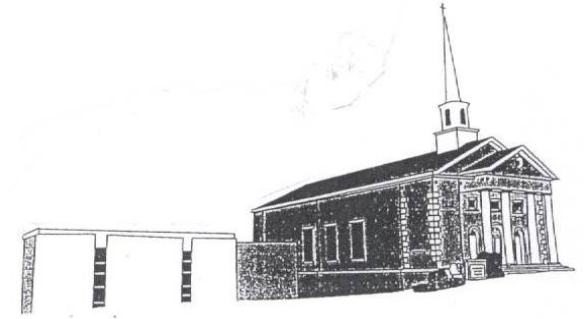
As of *Herald* press time, we have 9 representatives from Hardwick Baptist registered for this weekend’s March Mission Madness. I am excited that we have a group of students who will be exposed to “the Madness.” I attended sixteen consecutive Madnesses with students in Madison (2001-2016) and it became our favorite student event of the spring semester. March Mission Madness is a weekend of missions/ministry, service, worship, and fun for students in Grades 6-12. The event is sponsored by the Cooperative Baptist Fellowship of Georgia, which assists with the cost and the programming. CBF of Georgia partners with the local host church in the promotion, organization, and registration for the event. When I was at Madison Baptist Church our congregation hosted two separate Madness weekends: in 2003 and 2015. It was an amazing experience to have over 300 students, representing Baptist youth groups from around the state, gathering to serve and work in our community. In 2003 we had fifteen different mission sites—most of them involving exterior painting for residents who did not have the means to address the repairs on their own. The gratitude expressed by the people we served was worth all the time and effort.

What I love most about March Mission Madness is that it helps students (and adult chaperones) experience the connection between worship and service. There is always a theme for the weekend, which is addressed by the preacher during the three times of worship. But the students do not simply hear about faith and following Christ, they have the opportunity to put hands and feet to their faith by serving several hours on Saturday. It also is encouraging for youth to be around other students from churches across the state. It gives them a bigger picture of the church. This year’s Madness will be hosted by Maranatha Baptist Church in Plains (where President Carter is a faithful member), where Saturday evening worship will take place. Other worship times will be at the historic Rylander Theater in Americus. On Saturday our time will be split between work at a mission site and Habitat for Humanity’s Global Village. It should be a powerful weekend for those who will attend. Please remember the entire experience, and those who will participate, as you pray the next few days.
