**Thoughts From Doug**

Hardwick Baptist will be combining with First Baptist Church, Fayetteville, NC, for a summer mission trip. A dear friend and former youth group member, Rob Jones, is pastor at Fayetteville. Some of you may have met Rob and his family when they attended worship at HBC the Sunday after Thanksgiving. At that time Rob mentioned to me the possibility of our joining them for their summer mission trip. We have continued to talk, and last week I received the details from Paul Yoder, youth minister at FBC Fayetteville. I discussed it with our deacons this past Sunday, and we decided to proceed. Here is some basic information.

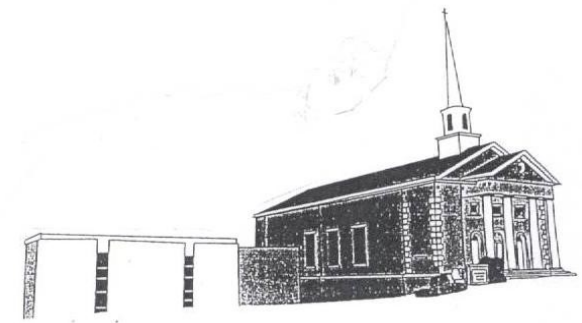
- When: July 22-27
- Where: Red Springs Mission Camp, Red Springs, NC  
(North Carolina Baptists on Mission camp)
- Who: Open to all adults and youth (Entering Grade 7 & up)  
Adults and youth will be placed on mission teams as directed by the staff, with adults serving as either Team Leader or Team motivator for teams composed of mostly youth. Each team will have an experienced staff member to assist on projects.
- What: We will be working in areas of construction, painting, and landscaping to help those in need. Possible projects include wheelchair ramps, sheetrock, painting homes, clearing bushes, mowing yards, and debris cleanup. We will have morning devotions and evening worship each day.

I will be publicizing other details soon, such as cost and deadlines for committing. As far as why we are going to North Carolina (since there are plenty in our own state who need help): I felt this was a good opportunity to join up with a mission trip that is already planned. Regardless how many from HBC can go, we will be able to participate in impactful work by joining the folks from Fayetteville. My hope is that this experience can inspire us to plan our own mission trip in 2020. But for now, this will be a good time to make friends with a sister church in North Carolina. The work will aid in the flood relief effort following Hurricane Florence, when an estimated 10 trillion gallons of rain fell on North Carolina. Hundreds of homes and businesses were damaged or destroyed during the storm and its aftermath. Red Springs Mission Camp will be our base, but we will be working in neighboring areas. I hope you will consider joining us!

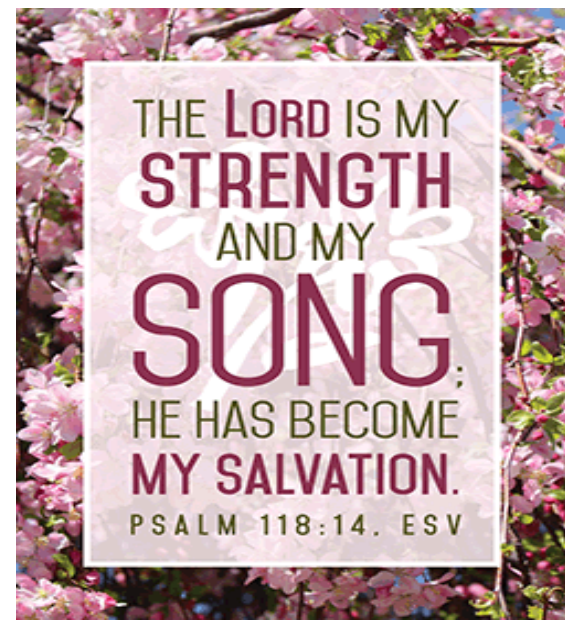
