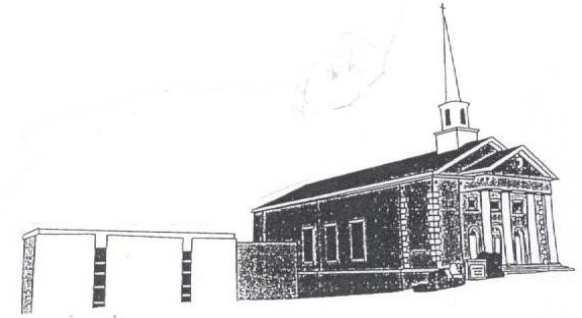
Thoughts From Doug
