WHAT IS A DAWNINGS RETREAT?

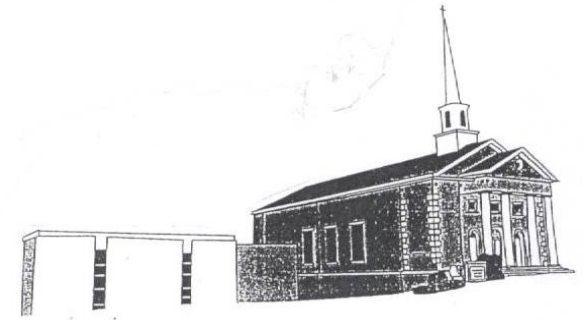
The *Dawnings Retreat* will be May 31-June 1. We are hosting this retreat, led by Bo Prosser and sponsored by the Cooperative Baptist Fellowship of Georgia. I have served as a coach for the Dawnings process and have seen the impact it has on congregations. And I use the word *process* intentionally because Dawnings is not a program. It teaches a congregation a process of discerning the Spirit’s work and God’s leading as we seek to be a missional people. It helps a church pay attention to the Holy Spirit as we discover what it is God is calling us to do and who it is God is calling us to be at this time in our congregational life. I will be recruiting a group of folks - who represent various parts of the congregation - to attend the retreat. The retreat will be an introduction to the Dawnings process. It will be held in our fellowship hall. We will begin with supper Friday night followed by Session 1. We will return to our homes, then come back Saturday morning for breakfast; Sessions 2 & 3; lunch; Sessions 4 & 5; and conclude around 5:00 PM. Two other churches will be sending teams: Community Baptist Church and Haddock Baptist Church. Please pray for this endeavor, and for the representatives from Hardwick Baptist who will be involved. Pray for the dawning of a new day in our life as a people on a missional journey with Christ.
