Online Giving

As of May 1st, online giving is now available through our website: hardwickbaptist.org by clicking on the "online giving" button at the top of each page. This will be an easy, convenient way to contribute to the church at any time from anywhere on any device or computer. You can use your debit or credit card or pay using your checking or savings account. You can make a one time contribution or set up a recurring (weekly, monthly, etc) contribution.

First you will need to set up an online profile with your personal and banking information. Then choose your payment method, the fund you wish to contribute to, the start date, frequency and amount. Your contribution will then be processed and deposited into the church bank account. The transaction is processed by Vanco, a secure company that we use for our church financial system.

Summer Mission Trip

A couple of moths ago I mentioned in my Herald article that we would be participating in a mission trip this summer. I wanted to remind everyone of the details as the summer is fast approaching. The dates of the trip are July 22-27. The trip is open to everyone in Grade 6 & Up—youth and adults. We will be joining FBC Fayetteville, NC for this event. We will be staying at Red Springs Mission Camp, Red Springs, NC. We will eat meals, worship, and sleep at the camp. We will have orientation on Monday the 22nd (we will be leaving Hardwick around 6:30 A.M. that day). Tuesday-Friday our schedule will be:

- Breakfast & Morning Devotions
- Work at mission Sites (lunch on site)
- Dinner and Evening Worship

Cost of the trip is \$235 - which covers meals and lodging at the camp. There is a \$100 deposit that is due June 16, with the balance due July 14. We are working on a couple of fundraisers (after church meals) to help defray the cost. Scholarship assistance is available; please see Doug.

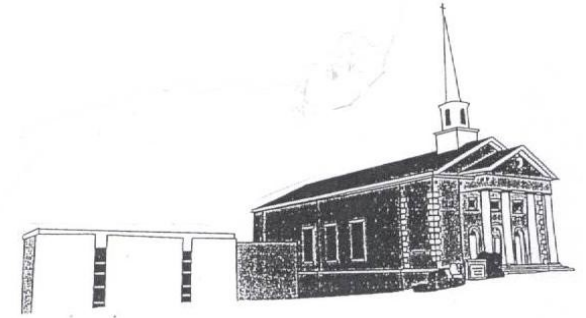
We will be working in areas that were severely affected by the flooding from Hurricane Florence last September. The work will consist of construction, painting, and landscaping. Possible activities include building wheelchair ramps, sheetrock, painting homes, clearing bushes, mowing yards, and debris cleanup. No skills are required. Team members will work at various locations as part of a team of ten or so. Each team will have a Team Leader and a Team Motivator. Teams will consist of youth and adults working together.
