Welcome Home , Bo Prosser!

I am so looking forward to having Bo Prosser with us this coming weekend. Even before I accepted the call as pastor of Hardwick Baptist, I contemplated some things I hoped to expose our congregation to. One thing that came to the top of my list was the Dawnings process (notice I do not use the word *program* - Dawnings is a process of discerning God's leading, not a program). I knew that I wanted to help us understand and enter into a practice of making our church planning a spiritual endeavor, and I knew that Dawnings would help me in this goal. I also knew that Bo Prosser had been involved in the creation and facilitation of the Dawnings curriculum. So, when I realized Bo's connection to Hardwick Baptist, I knew he was the person I wanted to "come home" and assist in the leading of our Dawnings Retreat. It is another confirmation, I believe, of the Spirit's conspiring among us as we look to the dawning of new day in our life as a church.


In preparation for Bo's visit, I wanted to give a little update on Bo's ministry and life since leaving Hardwick, as I know many of you do not know him. Bo was an active member of Hardwick during his youth years - as he still speaks of how formative HBC was in his life. Bo received an Associate's degree from Georgia military College, and a Bachelor's degree from Georgia College. He also received a Master of Divinity from the Southern Baptist Theological Seminary, and a Doctorate of Education from North Carolina State University. He served on the ministerial staff of several churches, most recently as Associate Pastor of Providence Baptist Church, Charlotte, NC. He left Providence to join the staff of the Cooperative Baptist Fellowship at the headquarters in Atlanta. For several years his job with CBF related to Congregational Life - assisting congregations as they navigated the waters of seeking to be faithful to Baptist distinctives in a post-modern world. Currently, his role at CBF national is Director of the Ministerial Excellence Initiative. As always, Bo has his hands in a variety of efforts. Besides his work for CBF, he is president of the Center for Christian Education. He also is a certified life coach, working through Creative Coaching services. In February he completed an interim pastorate at Providence Baptist Church, Charleston, SC. He continues to serve as a consultant to congregations and pastors. And he also is a songwriter at RainBo & Watermelon Music. As far as family life - Bo is married to Gail, and they have two grown daughters. They currently reside in Youngsville, NC near Raleigh.

As you can see Bo's path has taken him to several places since leaving Hardwick. It has been 30 years since he was here - so we have a lot of catching up to do. Those of you who will be attending the Dawnings Retreat will have some extra time with him. Also, he will be spending the Sunday School hour with one of our couples' classes. I hope you will be present to share in this "homecoming" this Sunday.
