I am so grateful for the good work that Cindy Folendore and Will Cooper have begun in their new roles at Hardwick Baptist. While Will's internship is almost half over, I am confident that he will continue to serve with us in a volunteer role during the school year as his student teaching allows. He has a heart for service and a love for our students. At the moment, Cindy's responsibilities as Minister with Community are taking shape in two areas: 1. Helping us do the foundational work for Dinner Church, which we hope to start in October; 2. Cindy, as the elected minister with Community, will be the leader for the newly-formed Community Ministries Team. The job description of this team is as follows:

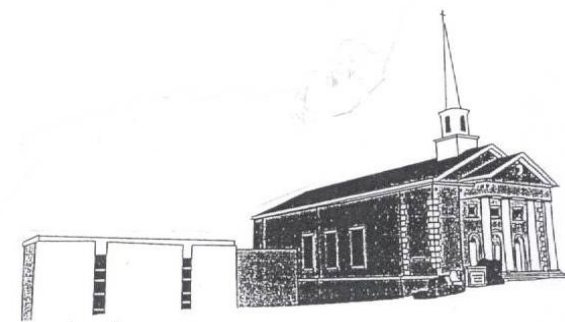
