As you have likely heard, plans are in the works for a Dinner Church to begin at Hardwick Baptist. Our hope is that we will have the first Dinner Church evening meal and worship in early or mid-October. One representative group from our church attended a Dinner Church in Douglasville a couple of months ago; we are planning on another group attending in early August.

In order for as many people as possible to understand the whys and the hows of Dinner Church—especially its’ connection to Jesus’ model of ministry and its purpose for outreach in our community—we are planning a special Sunday School effort for the month of August. After discussing with Jim Davis (Sunday School Director) and Cindy Folendore (Minister with Community), we decided to use the Sunday School hour during August as an opportunity to educate our congregation—as well as, hopefully, enhance some fellowship between our adult Sunday School classes. With that in mind, please be aware of this change for August.

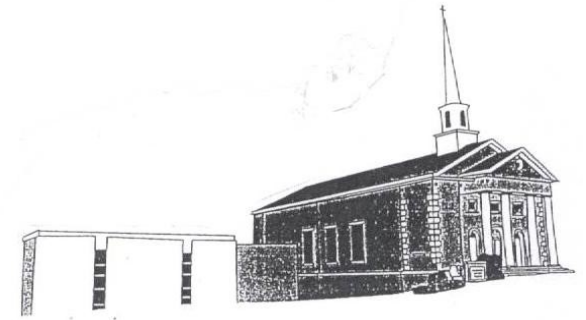
During the four Sundays in August, all adult Sunday School classes will meet in the Fellowship Hall for the entire Sunday School hour. We will have an “Adult Churchwide” four-week Sunday School unit, utilizing the video series that explains Dinner Church. There will be Bible passages to read each week, and there will be small group discussion around each table after the video is viewed. We will be watching two video sessions each of the four weeks, so we will need to begin promptly at 10:00 with the videos. That will allow 15 minutes (from 9:45 until 10:00) for teachers to take care of attendance matters. We will conclude soon after the Sunday School bell rings at 10:45.

Participating in this series will enable you to pray more specifically for our outreach effort. It will also make you better informed, so that you can discern the ways in which God may be inviting you to find a way to serve in our Dinner Church efforts. And if you are an old friend of Hardwick Baptist who still receives the *Herald*, I encourage you to pray for us and for the people to whom we are called to reach through food, fellowship and worship.
