**Come Join Us for Weekly Lunch!**

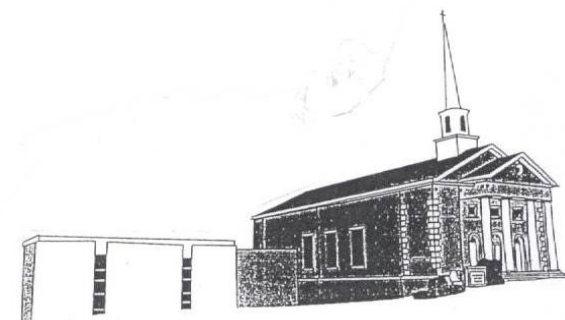
All adults at HBC (and friends) - please know that we would love to have you join us for our weekly lunch and Bible discussion Wednesdays at noon. If you are working and can get away for the noon hour, you are welcome to arrive whenever you can, and leave whenever you need. We typically eat first, then begin discussing the prayer list around 12:15, with the hope of looking at the Scripture reading by 12:35. We read one of the four lectionary readings for that particular week. If you are using our *Resource for Daily Prayer and Scripture Meditation* as it is designed, by Wednesday you will have gone through the first cycle of praying with each of the four readings. We typically divide our lunch Bible discussion into two parts: Informational and Formational. During the *informational* time, we discuss the basic information and context of that particular Bible reading, often utilizing a commentary as resource. During the *formational* time we switch over to personal insights, asking: *What particular word is addressed to me from this passage? How does this require me to change?*

Each Wednesday we have rich insights from the attendees. If you have not been able to join us, I hope you are able to some time in the future, as I anticipate we will continue this form of mid-week Prayer Meeting and Bible Discussion through the coming months. And as a reminder, here is the pattern for praying with the Scriptures using our *Resource for Daily Prayer and Scripture Meditation*:

- Monday: Psalm prayer and Old Testament Lesson
- Tuesday: Psalm prayer and Epistle Lesson
- Wednesday: Psalm prayer and New Testament Lesson
- Thursday: Psalm prayer and Old Testament Lesson  
(with questions)
- Friday: Psalm prayer and Epistle Lesson  
(with questions)
- Saturday: Psalm prayer and New Testament Lesson  
(with questions)
- Sunday: A deeper connection as you hear the passages read in worship
